Over \$80,000 Raised for Mid-Michigan Families at Highfields Golf Outing

*Onondaga, Michigan – June 22, 2018* –Highfields’ 38<sup>th</sup> Annual Golf Outing – the longest-running charitable golf outing in the Lansing area – raised more than \$80,000 for programs that help at-risk children and struggling families.

The outing took place on June 11<sup>th</sup> at Forest Akers West. After golfing, guests participated in a Live “Fund-a-Need” Auction called “Bring a Family Together.” The donations totaled over \$8,000 to bring family members to Highfields’ Onondaga campus for Family Treatment Weekends as part of the Residential Treatment Program.

During Family Treatment Weekends, family members are able to stay on campus with their children and participate in engaging family activities, and receive parenting education and support.

“Family Treatment Weekends are one of the most unique aspects of our residential treatment program,” said Brian Philson, President and CEO of Highfields. “We are grateful to have the support of so many individuals, companies, and organizations who believe in our mission.”

Last year, Highfields’ “Fund-a-Need” Auction focused on camperships for children with special needs, and raised over \$6,700.
