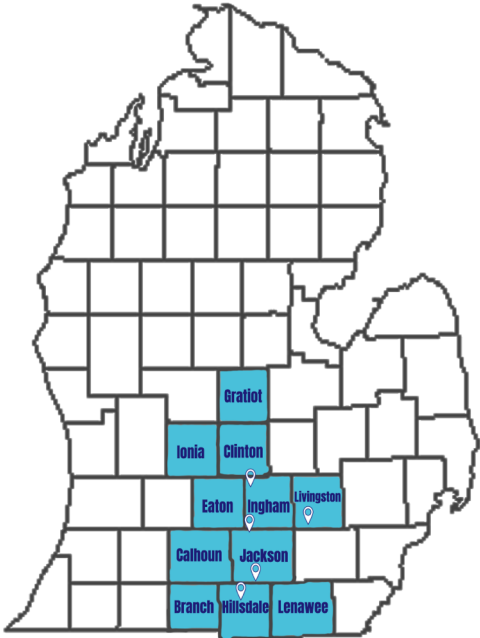
Mission Statement: To provide opportunities to children, youth and families to become more responsible for their own lives and to strengthen their relationships with others

- Highfields was founded in 1962.
- The current CEO and President is Brian Philson, LMSW, ACSW.
- A residential treatment facility is located at the main Onondaga Campus.
- Highfields offers community-based programs and counseling services in the areas of behavioral health, child welfare and mental health.
- Highfields offers educational services such as Breakthrough, an experiential education program in Onondaga, and eight Out of School Time Learning Programs called Reaching Higher.
- Highfields has an alternative high school called Ingham Academy which is a partnership between Highfields, Ingham County Circuit Court, Peckham and Ingham Intermediate School District.
- Highfields provides an evening reporting program for youth involved with
